BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	§711- Endangering public health and safety by using
5	body-gripping traps . (a) Notwithstanding section 183D-6, it
6	shall be unlawful to use, set, place, maintain, or tend, or
7	cause to be used, set, placed, maintained, or tended any
8	body-gripping trap.
9	(b) For purposes of this section, the term "body-gripping
10	trap" includes steel-jawed leghold traps, padded jaw leghold
11	traps, conibear traps, and snares, the last of which are
12	commonly referred to as cable restraints.
13	(c) Subsection (a) shall not apply to:
14	(1) Federal, state, or county departments of health when
15	protecting human health and safety; or
16	(2) The use of traps for the purpose of controlling wild
17	or domestic rodents.
18	(d) An offense under this section is a misdemeanor."
