A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAID.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The Affordable Care Act, P.L. 111-148, requires 2 that by January 1, 2014 states are to have established a 3 functional health insurance exchange. States are required to 4 use the information from applications submitted through the 5 exchange to determine eligibility for medicaid. Hawaii's current twenty-three-year-old information technology system for 6 7 determining medicaid eligibility is not capable of performing 8 the functions required by the Affordable Care Act, P.L. 111-148. 9 Because numerous states are facing issues presented by 10 antiquated medicaid-related information technology systems, the United States Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services is 11 12 expected to make available ninety per cent federal matching 13 funds for specific types of eligibility system upgrades.

14 A new information technology system for determining 15 medicaid eligibility will streamline the eligibility process, 16 allow greater transparency to the community and applicants, and 17 facilitate increased integrity of recipient eligibility through 18 electronic interfaces for data verification. this Act is to provide funds to establish a new information
technology system for determining medicaid eligibility within
the State, and to take advantage of the opportunity presented by
the provision of federal funding for this purpose.

5 There is appropriated out of the general SECTION 2. 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,000,000 or so much 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 to provide 8 funding for the implementation of a new system for determining 9 medicaid eligibility; provided that no funds shall be made 10 available under this Act unless the United States Centers for 11 Medicare and Medicaid Services provides ninety per cent of the 12 funds required for the purpose for which this sum is 13 appropriated; provided further that the new system for 14 determining medicaid eligibility shall perform the functions 15 required by the Affordable Care Act, P.L. 111-148, streamline 16 the eligibility process, allow greater transparency to the community and applicants, and facilitate increased integrity of 17 recipient eligibility through electronic interfaces for data 18 19 verification.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 21 human services for the purposes of this Act.
