A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WELLNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that seventy per cent of
 chronic conditions are related to personal behaviors and
 unhealthy lifestyle choices. It is important to develop
 initiatives that positively influence healthy behavior related
 to physical activity and increased fruit and vegetable
 consumption.

7 The legislature also finds that Hawaii must comply with 8 federal health reform legislation requirements by 2014, 9 including mandating physician reimbursements for outcomes rather 10 than transactions. Therefore the legislature is interested in 11 authorizing and evaluating health and wellness alternatives 12 that:

13 (1) Reduce the incidence of chronic disease;
14 (2) Support families in adopting and maintaining healthier
15 lifestyles; and

16 (3) Reduce the costs of health care expenditures
17 associated with emergency care and other hospital-

18 based treatments for avoidable chronic diseases.
