BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended SECTION 1. 2 by adding a new section to part XIII to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 "§11- Contributions not expended for another state or 5 county office. Contributions shall be expended for the office sought by the candidate at the time the contribution is received 6 7 and shall not be expended by the candidate in an election for 8 another state or county office without the contributor's written 9 consent." 10 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 12
