SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COORDINATED PLAN TO ASSIST HOME GARDENERS WITH FORMING COMMUNITY-BASED, HOME ORGANIC PRODUCE COOPERATIVES.

WHEREAS, home gardeners who grow fruits and vegetables for 1 2 their own consumption often have a surplus of these fruits and vegetables; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, if home gardeners could be organized into 6 cooperatives, their surpluses could be sold in local markets and 7 the State would be less dependent on imported produce; and 8 9 WHEREAS, home organic produce cooperatives could be a means 10 to: 11 12 (1)Educate home gardeners about growing organic produce; 13 (2) Assist home gardeners with marketing their produce; 14 15 and 16 (3) Advise home gardeners on any other pertinent matters 17 relating to the marketing and selling of surplus 18 organic produce to the general public; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the State supports the development of the organic 21 industry as a viable agricultural practice that promotes both 22 the recycling of bioregional resources and local production and 23 consumption for a self-reliant industry; and 24 25 WHEREAS, the Makiki Neighborhood Board of the City and 26 27 County of Honolulu supports the establishment of home organic 28 produce cooperatives; now, therefore, 29 30 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth 31 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, the House of Representatives concurring, that the University of 32

Hawaii College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources, 1 2 through its Cooperative Extension Service and with assistance 3 from the Department of Agriculture and the Department of 4 Business, Economic Development, and Tourism, is urged to develop 5 a coordinated plan to assist home gardeners with forming 6 community-based, home organic produce cooperatives; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the University of Hawaii is 9 requested to submit a progress report on developing the plan no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 2012 10 Regular Session; and 11

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 14 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the 15 University of Hawaii, the Dean of the College of Tropical 16 Agriculture and Human Resources, the Chairperson of the Board of 17 Agriculture, the Director of Business, Economic Development, and 18 Tourism, and the Chairperson of the Makiki Neighborhood Board. 19
