SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO ASSESS THE SOCIAL AND FINANCIAL EFFECTS OF REQUIRING HEALTH INSURERS TO PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR AN ANNUAL MEDICAL EXAMINATION, INCLUDING THE ADMINISTRATION OF ANY REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS, FOR EACH CHILD WHO IS REQUIRED BY A SCHOOL IN THE STATE TO SUBMIT A REPORT OF A MEDICAL EXAMINATION TO THE SCHOOL.

1 WHEREAS, various schools in the State require a child's 2 health records to be submitted annually in the summer, including 3 evidence of any required immunizations, to the school as a 4 condition of the child's admission or return to the school each 5 year; and

7 WHEREAS, section 23-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires 8 that "[b]efore any legislative measure that mandates health insurance coverage for specific health services, specific 9 10 diseases, or certain providers of health care services as part of individual or group health insurance policies, can be 11 12 considered, there shall be concurrent resolutions passed requesting the auditor to prepare and submit to the legislature 13 a report that assesses both the social and financial effects of 14 the proposed mandated coverage"; and 15

17 WHEREAS, section 23-51 further provides that "[t]he 18 concurrent resolutions shall designate a specific legislative 19 bill that:

21 (1) Has been introduced in the legislature; and 22 Includes, at a minimum, information identifying the: 23 (2) 24 25 Specific health service, disease, or provider (A) that would be covered; 26 27 28 Extent of the coverage; (B) 29

No. annual medical examination, including the administration of any 11 12 required immunizations, for each child who is required by a school in the State to submit a report of a medical examination, 13 14 including evidence of any required immunizations, to the school at the start of each school year in all policies and contracts, 15 16 hospital and medical service plan contracts, medical service corporation contracts, and health maintenance organization plans 17 and contracts issued on or after January 1, 2012; now, 18 therefore, 19 20 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, the 22 House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is 23 requested to conduct an impact assessment report, pursuant to 24 25 sections 23-51 and 23-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, of the social and financial impacts of mandating health insurance coverage for 26 27 an annual medical examination, including the administration of 28 any required immunizations, for each child who is required by a school in the State to submit a report of a medical examination, 29 30 including evidence of any required immunizations, to the school at the start of each school year, in all policies and contracts, 31 hospital and medical service plan contracts, medical service 32 33 corporation contracts, and health maintenance organization plans and contracts issued on or after January 1, 2012, as provided in 34 S.B. No. (2011); and 35 36 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Auditor is requested to submit 38 findings and recommendations to the Legislature, including any necessary implementing legislation, no later than twenty days 39 prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2012; and 40 41 42 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor and to the 43 Insurance Commissioner, who in turn is requested to transmit 44 SCR LRB 11-0424.doc

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copies to each insurer in the State that issues health insurance 1 policies. 2
