SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO ASSESS THE SOCIAL AND FINANCIAL EFFECTS OF REQUIRING HEALTH INSURERS TO PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR PHYSICAL THERAPY FOR CHRONIC PAIN THAT IS PRESCRIBED BY A BOARD-CERTIFIED SURGEON.

1 WHEREAS, patients who suffer chronic pain, who have 2 recurring injuries, or who have more than one injury within a 3 calendar year that requires physical therapy are currently 4 limited to receiving eight sessions of physical therapy per year 5 that is covered by health care insurance in the State; and

7 WHEREAS, these patients should be offered additional
8 physical therapy sessions only if prescribed by a board9 certified surgeon -- as opposed to a primary care
10 physician -- that is fully covered by health care insurance; and

WHEREAS, section 23-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires 12 that "[b]efore any legislative measure that mandates health 13 insurance coverage for specific health services, specific 14 diseases, or certain providers of health care services as part 15 of individual or group health insurance policies, can be 16 considered, there shall be concurrent resolutions passed 17 requesting the auditor to prepare and submit to the legislature 18 a report that assesses both the social and financial effects of 19 20 the proposed mandated coverage"; and

22 WHEREAS, section 23-51 further provides that "[t]he 23 concurrent resolutions shall designate a specific legislative 24 bill that:

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(1) Has been introduced in the legislature; and
(2) Includes, at a minimum, information identifying the:
(A) Specific health service, disease, or provider that would be covered;



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1 2	(B) Extent of the coverage;
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4 5	(C) Target groups that would be covered;
6 7	(D) Limits on utilization, if any; and
, 8 9	(E) Standards of care.
9 10	For purposes of this part, mandated health insurance coverage
11	shall not include mandated optionals"; and
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13	WHEREAS, section 23-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, further
14	specifies the minimum information required for assessing the
15 16	social and financial impact of the proposed health coverage mandate in the Auditor's report; and
17	mandate in the Auditor 5 report, and
18	WHEREAS, S.B. No. (2011) mandates coverage for physical
19	therapy for chronic pain that is prescribed by a board-certified
20	surgeon for all policies and contracts, hospital and medical
21	service plan contracts, medical service corporation contracts, and health maintenance organization plans and contracts issued
22 23	after December 31, 2011; and
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25	WHEREAS, the Legislature believes that mandatory health
26	insurance coverage for physical therapy for chronic pain, as
27	provided in S.B. No. (2011), will substantially reduce
28 29	illness and assist in the maintenance of good health for the people of this State; now, therefore,

31	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth
32	Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, the
33	House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is
34	requested to conduct an impact assessment report, pursuant to
35 36	sections 23-51 and 23-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, of the social and financial impacts of mandating coverage for physical therapy
37	for chronic pain that is prescribed by a board-certified surgeon
38	for all policies and contracts, hospital and medical service
39	plan contracts, medical service corporation contracts, and
40	health maintenance organization plans and contracts issued after
41	December 31, 2011, as provided in S.B. No. (2011); and
42 43	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to
44	submit findings and recommendations to the Legislature,
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including any necessary implementing legislation, twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2012; and 3

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor and to the Insurance Commissioner, who in turn is requested to transmit copies to each insurer in the State that issues health insurance policies.
