## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CONVENING OF A WORKING GROUP TO EXPLORE WAYS TO ENCOURAGE STUDENT INTEREST IN FARMING AND AGRICULTURE.

1 2 3	WHEREAS, nationwide, school-children suffer from the effects of being overweight and obese at unparalleled rates; and
4 5 6 7	WHEREAS, the National Survey of Children's Health reports that 28.5 per cent of Hawaii's public school children are overweight or obese; and
8 9 10 11	WHEREAS, diets of processed food have not only affected children's physical well-being, but their knowledge and awareness of fresh food; and
12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, keeping children engaged and connected to the natural world is an important step toward a more sustainable future; now, therefore,
16 17 18 19 20 21 22	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of Agriculture is requested to convene a working group to explore ways to encourage the interest of young people in farming and agriculture; and
22 23 24	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group include:
25 26 27	(1) The Chairperson of the Board of Agriculture, or the Chairperson's designated representative;
28 29	(2) The Chairperson of the Board of Education, or the Chairperson's designated representative;
30 31 32 33	(3) The Chairperson of the Board of Directors of the Hawaii Farm Bureau Federation, or the Chairperson's designated representative;

1 2 (4) The Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, or the Chairperson's designated 3 4 representative; 5 6 (5) The Dean of the College of Tropical Agriculture and 7 Human Resources, University of Hawaii at Manoa, or the 8 Dean's designated representative; 9 10 (6) The Chairperson of the Board of Directors of the Hawaii Agricultural Research Center, or the 11 12 Chairperson's designated representative; 13 14 (7)The Chairperson of the Board of the Agribusiness 15 Development Corporation, or the Chairperson's 16 designated representative; and 17 18 (8) Working agriculturalists, including agriculturalists 19 from the fields of the seed and high technology sector, cattle and dairy industry, fresh produce and 20 21 tropical fruit industry, poultry industry, and 22 aquaculture and mariculture industry; and 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group is requested 25 to explore ways to establish partnerships between the public and private sectors to develop programs that: 26 27 28 (1)Engage elementary school students through means such as field trips to farms and cultivating garden plots; 29 30 31 (2)Maintain interest as students progress through high school, using means such as stipends for students who 32 33 work in agricultural business; and 34 35 (3) Continue interest as students progress through college, using means such as scholarships for students 36 who are in agriculture-related degree programs; and 37 38 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature requests that the programs explored by the working group focus on teaching 40 41 technology, science, and business methods to establish a global 42 view of food production; and 43

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Agriculture 1 2 is requested to submit a report of the working group's findings, recommendations, and any proposed legislation to the Legislature 3 no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular 4 5 Session of 2012; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 8 Board of Agriculture; the Chairperson of the Board of Education; 9 the Superintendent of Education; the Chairperson of the Board of 10 11 Directors of the Hawaii Farm Bureau Federation; the Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources; the Dean of the 12 College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources, University 13 14 of Hawaii at Manoa; the Chairperson of the Board of Agribusiness 15 Development Corporation; and the Chairperson of the Board of 16 Directors of the Hawaii Agricultural Research Center. 17
