SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING AN ANNUAL EVALUATION OF THE GOVERNOR'S SIX-YEAR STATE PROGRAM AND FINANCIAL PLAN FOR INFORMATION TO PROMOTE AND GUIDE JOB GROWTH.

WHEREAS, the struggling economy has stalled the creation of 1 jobs in the State; and 2

WHEREAS, public and private employment have been reduced due to a decrease in revenues; and

WHEREAS, to revitalize the local economy, government must 7 design and implement an effective job creation plan; and 8

WHEREAS, the establishment of a job creation plan requires 10 the collection of current and accurate economic and employment 11 data in the State; and 12

WHEREAS, prior to the regular session of each odd-numbered 14 year and along with the proposed state budget, the Governor is 15 required under section 37-69, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to submit 16 to the Legislature a proposed six-year state program and 17 financial plan that summarizes financial information for 18 operational spending, debt, and capital projects; and 19

21 WHEREAS, the state program and financial plan includes, among other things, state and county economic data and 22 projections for the ensuing six fiscal years relating to 23 population, employment rates and figures, industry and 24 occupational surpluses and shortages, income, wages and prices, 25 industry and business trends, and the effects of national 26 economic and financial policies and conditions; and 27

29 WHEREAS, because the state program and financial plan is annually and continuously updated, the plan's components can be 30 31 used for annual assessments of job creation in Hawaii and to assist the Executive Branch and the Legislature in planning for 32 legislation and anticipated projects promoting job growth; now, 33 therefore, 34
