SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE GOVERNOR TO ALLOCATE FUNDS AND WORK WITH REPUTABLE COMPANIES TO PROVIDE TRANSITIONAL HOUSING AND SOCIAL SERVICES FOR HOMELESS PERSONS ON OAHU'S NORTH SHORE.

WHEREAS, there are a number of homeless individuals and families on Oahu's north shore, including in the town of Wahiawa: and 3

WHEREAS, because these people face many obstacles and 5 challenges in their efforts to find housing, remedies must be 6 tailored to their various needs and there should be a continuum 7 of housing and services made available; and 8

WHEREAS, the north shore lacks an adequate supply of 10 transitional housing where homeless people can stay and receive 11 support while transitioning into permanent housing; and 12 13

WHEREAS, homeless support services, such as classes on life 14 15 skills and financial literacy, are also in low supply in areas throughout the north shore of Oahu; now, therefore, 16 17

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth 18 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, 19 that the Governor is urged to allocate funds and work with 20 reputable companies to provide transitional housing and social 21 22 services on Oahu's north shore; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 24 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor. 25
