SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO CONVENE A TASK FORCE TO DEVELOP A STREAM MAINTENANCE AND FLOOD HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, flooding is a major problem for various parts of 1 the State, not only causing physical damage to structures, but 2 also creating dangerous travel conditions that lead to road 3 4 closures and the potential loss of life; and 5 WHEREAS, the flash flooding of Puuhulu Stream in Waianae 6 Valley in December of 2008 and in January of 2011 caused 7 8 significant erosion of the banks along the stream and property 9 damage; and 10 WHEREAS, the lack of drainage has caused recurring flooding 11 of the Lualualei Watershed in Waianae Valley, resulting in 12 unsafe road conditions, flooded streets, homes, vegetable farms, 13 ranches, hog farms, and flooding on the United States Navy 14 facility at Lualualei; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, the flash flooding along the Honouliuli Stream in Ewa in December of 2008 and January of 2011 resulted in water 18 and debris sweeping through farms, ranches, and neighborhoods; 19 20 and 21 WHEREAS, the flash flooding along the Waiahole Stream in 22 windward Oahu in December of 2008 and January of 2011 resulted 23 in the continued erosion of stream banks and damage to private 24 25 property, including repetitive damage to a plant nursery; and 26 WHEREAS, the flash flooding along the Kaukonahua Stream, 27 Paukauila Stream, Opaeula Stream, and Helemano Stream in the 28 Waialua Watershed, north shore Oahu, in December 2008 continued 29 30 damage that has included erosion of stream banks and damage to roads, homes, and businesses, and in 1974, the loss of life; and 31 32 WHEREAS, the flash flooding along the Hanalei River, Kauai 33 County, in 2010 resulted in the breach of stream banks, causing 34



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a diversion away from the irrigation systems on which taro farms 1 depend; and 2 3 4 WHEREAS, addressing the State's flood concerns requires a 5 coordinated effort among private property owners and state, county, and federal agencies, along with necessary funding; now, 6 7 therefore, 8 9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, 10 11 that the Department of Land and Natural Resources is requested to convene a task force to develop a stream maintenance and 12 flood hazard mitigation plan; and 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force include: 15 16 The Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural 17 (1)Resources, or the Chairperson's designee; 18 19 (2)The Director of Civil Defense, or the Director's 20 designee; 21 22 (3) The Director of Transportation, or the Director's 23 24 designee; 25 The Chairperson of the Board of Agriculture, or the 26 (4)Chairperson's designee; 27 28 29 (5) A representative from the United States Army Corps of Engineers; 30 31 32 (6) A representative from the United States Army Pacific; 33 A representative from the United States Department of (7) 34 Agriculture; 35 36 37 (8) The Director of Emergency Management, City and County of Honolulu, or the Director's designee; 38 39 40 (9) The Director of Facility Maintenance, City and County of Honolulu, or the Director's designee; 41 42 The Director of Transportation Services, City and (10)43 County of Honolulu, or the Director's designee; 44 SR LRB 11-2612.doc



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1 The Director of Design and Construction, City and 2 (11)County of Honolulu, or the Director's designee; 3 4 5 The Director of Planning and Permitting, City and (12)6 County of Honolulu, or the Director's designee; 7 8 (13) The Director of Environmental Services, City and County of Honolulu, or the Director's designee; and 9 10 The Chairperson of the Board of Water Supply, City and 11 (14)County of Honolulu, or the Chairperson's designee; and 12 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to develop environmental, engineering, and functional solutions to 15 address short-term and long-term flooding issues in a 16 coordinated effort on an ongoing basis; and 17 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to 19 explore funding options to address the State's flood concerns; 20 and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to 23 report to the Legislature its findings and recommendations, 24 including any proposed legislation, no later than twenty days 25 prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2012; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 28 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Civil Defense, the 29 Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources; the 30 Director of Transportation; the Chairperson of the Board of 31 Agriculture; the Commander of the United States Army Corps of 32 Engineers, Pacific Ocean Division; the Commander of the United 33 States Army Pacific; the Secretary of the United States 34 Department of Agriculture; the Mayor of the City and County of 35 Honolulu; the Director of Emergency Management, City and County 36 of Honolulu; the Director of Facility Maintenance, City and 37 County of Honolulu; the Director of Transportation Services, 38 City and County of Honolulu; the Director of Design and 39 Construction, City and County of Honolulu; the Director of 40 Planning and Permitting, City and County of Honolulu; the 41 Director of Environmental Services, City and County of Honolulu; 42 43
