SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE STATE HAZARD MITIGATION FORUM TO STUDY MEASURES TO MITIGATE RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH STATE FLOOD HAZARDS.

WHEREAS, flooding is a major problem for various parts of 1 2 the State, not only causing physical damage to structures, but also creating dangerous travel conditions that lead to road 3 closures and the potential loss of life; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the flash flooding of Puuhulu Stream in Waianae 6 Valley in December of 2008 and January of 2011 caused 7 significant erosion of the banks along the stream and property 8 9 damage; and 10 WHEREAS, the lack of drainage has caused recurring flooding 11 of the Lualualei Watershed in Waianae Valley, resulting in 12 unsafe road conditions, flooded streets, homes, vegetable farms, 13 ranches, hog farms, and flooding on the United States Navy 14 15 facility at Lualualei; and 16 WHEREAS, the flash flooding along the Honouliuli Stream in 17 Ewa in December of 2008 and January of 2011 resulted in water 18 and debris sweeping through farms, ranches, and neighborhoods; 19 and 20 21 WHEREAS, the flash flooding along the Waiahole Stream in 22 windward Oahu in December of 2008 and January of 2011 resulted 23 in the continued erosion of stream banks and damage to private 24 property, including repetitive damage to a plant nursery; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, the flash flooding along the Kaukonahua Stream, 28 Paukauila Stream, Opaeula Stream, and Helemano Stream in the Waialua Watershed, north shore Oahu, in December 2008 continued 29 30 damage that has included erosion of stream banks and damage to roads, homes, and businesses, and in 1974, the loss of life; and 31 32 WHEREAS, the flash flooding along the Hanalei River, Kauai 33 County, in 2010 resulted in the breach of stream banks, causing 34

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a diversion away from the irrigation systems on which taro farms 1 depend; and 2 3 4 WHEREAS, addressing the State's flood concerns requires a 5 coordinated effort among private property owners and state, county, and federal agencies, along with necessary funding; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, the State Hazard Mitigation Forum comprises a broad spectrum of agencies to include representatives from all 9 four counties, the federal government, various state agencies, 10 and members of the private sector; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the State Hazard Mitigation Forum makes 13 recommendations to the Adjutant General with regard to grant 14 awards for statewide mitigation projects; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the State Hazard Mitigation Forum evaluates and 17 prioritizes measures to mitigate the risks associated with 18 hazards; now, therefore, 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth 21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, 22 that the State Hazard Mitigation Forum is urged to study 23 measures to mitigate risks associated with flood hazards; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State Hazard Mitigation 26 27 Forum is requested to explore funding options to address the. State's flood concerns; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State Hazard Mitigation 30 Forum is requested to report to the Legislature its findings and 31 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, no later 32 than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session 33 34 of 2012; and 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 36 Resolution be transmitted to the Adjutant General and 37 Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources. 38
