SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO REPORT ON THE FEASIBILITY OF HOLDING INTRA- AND INTER-SCHOOL COMPETITIONS ON THE SUBJECT OF SUSTAINABILITY.

WHEREAS, as an island state, Hawaii faces difficult 1 challenges in the area of sustainability; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the problems related to sustainability are varied 4 5 and complex; and 6 WHEREAS, complex and multi-faceted problems are best solved 7 when a multitude of people, minds, and ideas are engaged in 8 deriving solutions; and 9 10 WHEREAS, problem-solving may often be more effective when 11 the ideas come from young minds with fresh ideas that are not 12 clouded by a myriad of previously proposed solutions; and 13 14 WHEREAS, competition is a proven method of inspiring 15 innovation and new ideas; and 16 17 WHEREAS, Hawaii's public school students are an excellent 18 resource for innovative ideas and problem solving; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, the students are already familiar with the basic sustainability framework of the three R's - reduce, reuse, and 22 recycle; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the basic idea of the three R's is an excellent 25 topic and starting point for a series of competitions designed 26 to inspire students to develop creative ideas toward solving the 27 complex issues regarding sustainability in Hawaii; and 28 29 WHEREAS, sustainability competitions are being held in 30 schools in Nevada, New Jersey, England, and Australia and on the 31 national level in the United States; and 32 33 WHEREAS, school competitions related to formulating ideas 34 to achieve sustainability will not only increase the awareness 35

and knowledge of sustainability issues among the students but
 also lead to the formation of real solutions that can be
 employed to lead the State toward a sustainable future; now,
 therefore,

6 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth 7 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, 8 that the Department of Education is requested to study the 9 feasibility of creating and implementing intra- and inter-school 10 competitions in the three R's of sustainability - reduce, reuse, 11 and recycle; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a report to the Legislature regarding the feasibility of creating and implementing intraand inter-school competitions in the three R's of sustainability be submitted no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2012; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
Resolution be transmitted to the Superintendent of Education,
Chairperson of the Board of Education, Executive Director of the
Charter School Administrative Office, all Complex Area
Superintendents, and all public school principals.
