SENATE RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING THE NEED TO REACH OUT TO HAWAII WOMEN AND ENGAGE THEM IN THE POLITICAL PROCESS.

1 WHEREAS, women are an important and significant force in 2 Hawaii and it is in the best interest of the State to empower 3 and actively engage them in the political process; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Patsy T. Mink Political Action Committee 6 recently surveyed six hundred seventy-one women in Hawaii eligible to vote, and found that seventy-two per cent of women 7. are more concerned with issues that directly affect their 8 families and everyday life than participating in the political 9 process and engaging in larger social and economic issues; and 10 11 12 WHEREAS, the survey also found that the lack of interest 13 and participation in public affairs by women stems from a 14 variety of causes, including a limited knowledge about or interest in the candidates, apathy, and a general distrust of 15 the system, which is perceived as flawed and corrupt; and 16 17 18 WHEREAS, a majority of the survey respondents have never contacted an elected official to express their concerns and a 19 mere four per cent of those women believe that their concerns 20 would be taken seriously if they were voiced; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, it is crucial for the State to engage women who feel disenfranchised and to assure them their voices are being 24 heard; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, women would be more likely to engage in government if elected officials focused on issues most important to them, 28 29 including the high cost of living, higher quality education, affordable housing, and more job opportunities; now, therefore, 30 31

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-Sixth 1 2 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, 3 that this body requests the Legislature to encourage women to 4 take active roles in public life, including business and 5 government, and to provide the support for women to fully 6 participate by recognizing the need for educational 7 opportunities and family care; and 8

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature is requested to 10 involve women more fully in the policymaking process, including playing an important leadership role in the planning and 11 execution of legislative priorities; and 12 13

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature is requested to 15 focus on the issues shown to be important to women, issues that directly impact the everyday lives of all women, including the 16 high cost of living, higher quality education, affordable 17 18 housing, and more job opportunities; and 19

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the President of the 21 22 Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the 23 Chairperson and the Executive Director of the Hawaii State Commission on Status of Women, and the Chairperson of the Patsy 24 T. Mink Political Action Committee. 25
