SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING DEPARTMENTS AND OTHER AGENCIES OF THE STATE AND THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO DESIGNATE GOVERNMENT PARKING LOTS FOR USE AT NIGHT BY THE HOMELESS WHO OWN VEHICLES AND SLEEP IN THEIR VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, as a result of the depressed economy, in the last
few years the State of Hawaii and the City and County of
Honolulu have experienced increasing numbers of homeless persons
in Hawaii; and

6 WHEREAS, while homelessness is an issue that cuts across 7 cultural lines, the primary common denominator in the plight of 8 the homeless is the lack of affordable housing; and

10 WHEREAS, there are many circumstances that drive people out 11 of their homes, such as substance abuse, serious health 12 problems, mental health conditions, being a war veteran, aging 13 out of the foster care system, in-migration from the mainland, 14 and inability to afford rent; and

16 WHEREAS, according to the Homeless Service Utilization 17 Report prepared by the Center on the Family at the University of 18 Hawaii and the Homeless Programs Office of the Department of 19 Human Services, for 2010 there were 9,781 homeless persons on 20 Oahu who received City and County of Honolulu services and 21 13,886 statewide who received related services; and 22

WHEREAS, the actual number of homeless persons is higher than these unofficial counts, as providers of homeless services who do not receive state funding are not required to report the numbers of their clients; and

28 WHEREAS, children and youth comprise thirty-five percent of29 the homeless population who live in shelters; and

31 WHEREAS, among those who live in shelters, forty-two 32 percent have children, and of these, seventy-six percent are 33 families led by their mothers; and

1 WHEREAS, thirty-five percent of those who live in shelters 2 have been homeless between one and eleven months; and 3 WHEREAS, many homeless persons sleep in their cars wherever 4 5 they can find a safe place to park their car; and 6 WHEREAS, state and municipal parking lots are largely empty 7 8 during night hours, the time when the homeless need a place to sleep; now, therefore, 9 10 11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, 12 that departments and other agencies of the State and the City 13 and County of Honolulu are requested to designate government 14 15 parking lots for use by homeless persons who own their own 16 vehicles and sleep in the vehicles, between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.; 17 and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the parking lot at the Aloha 20 Stadium be designated for use between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. by 21 homeless persons who own their own vehicles; and 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that toilet facilities and security 24 be provided by the State and the City and County of Honolulu, or 25 other stakeholders, at designated sites between 10 p.m. and 26 6 a.m.; and 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Mayor of the City and 29 County of Honolulu, and each department head of the State and 30 the City and County of Honolulu. 31
