SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING APPLICATION FOR, GRANTING OF, AND FISCAL SUPPORT FOR EMERGENCY RELIEF AND EMERGENCY PREVENTION EFFORTS FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU IN THE WAKE OF THE MARCH 11, 2011, TSUNAMI.

1 WHEREAS, the Japanese earthquake on March 10, 2011, and the resulting tsunami on March 10th and 11th caused catastrophic 2 damage to the country of Japan, resulting in widespread loss of 3 life; and 4 5 WHEREAS, according to United States Geological Survey 6 7 records, the earthquake measuring 8.9 on the richter scale was the strongest in recorded history to hit Japan; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, many residents of Hawaii have been deeply affected 11 by the disaster and especially by the tsunami generated by the earthquake; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, the tsunami caused significant damage within the City and County of Honolulu; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, one of the hardest hit areas on Oahu was the Keehi Lagoon, where at least twenty-five boats sank and two hundred 18 boats were damaged when their floating docks broke loose, and 19 20 Haleiwa also experienced significant damage; and 21 22 WHEREAS, many businesses and homes will need to be rebuilt 23 or restored as a result of the tsunami; and 24 25 WHEREAS, immediate action and emergency relief are needed to restore general health and safety to the City and County of 26 Honolulu and to limit economic hardship and job loss; now, 27 therefore, 28 29 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-sixth 30 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, 31 32 that the City and County of Honolulu is requested to apply for the maximum amount of federal relief funds available and to 33 34 cover the requisite cost share for the Federal Emergency



1 Management Agency's public assistance program and individual assistance program, as required by the Robert T. Stafford 2 Disaster and Emergency Assistance Act; and 3 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State is hereby requested to assist the City and County of Honolulu to recover from the 6 7 tsunami by maximizing available matching funds for federal 8 reimbursements; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State of Hawaii assemble an 11 intergovernmental task force to expedite relief for the City and County of Honolulu; and 12 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United States Congress is hereby urged to refrain from making any cuts to the critically 15 16 important Tsunami Pacific Alert System; and 17 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of Honolulu is requested to expedite building permits for home owners and 19 business owners who suffered damage to their properties from the 20 21 tsunami so that they may promptly rebuild their establishments 22 and more quickly recover from the destruction; and 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, United States 25 Congressional Delegation for Hawaii, Mayor of the City and 26 27 County of Honolulu, City and County of Honolulu Department of Planning and Permitting, and Director of the Hawaii office of 28

the Federal Emergency Management Agency. 29
