BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 342G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§342G- Municipal solid waste prohibition.</u> (a)
5	Beginning July 1, 2017, the largest landfill existing as of
6	January 1, 2011, in a county with a population greater than or
7	equal to five hundred thousand residents shall not accept
8	deliveries of municipal solid waste.
9	(b) After a date to be determined by resolution of the
10	respective legislative body of a county, no landfill in a county
11	with a population of less than five hundred thousand residents
12	shall accept deliveries of municipal solid waste.
13	(c) The prohibitions of this section shall not apply to
14	special waste or waste created as a result of a natural
15	disaster."
16	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
