The purpose of this bill is to strengthen the protections for the natural resources of the Kahoʻolawe Island Reserve by authorizing the imposition of seizure and forfeiture penalty provisions for a variety of items and equipment, including vehicles, vessels, and aircraft, used or taken in violation of the laws or rules applicable to the Kahoʻolawe Island Reserve.
