Your Committees on Hawaiian Affairs and Agriculture, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 224 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS TO PARTNER WITH THE OFFICE OF HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS AND OTHER APPROPRIATE ENTITIES TO PROVIDE SUPPORT SERVICES TO ITS BENEFICIARIES TO ENCOURAGE SUCCESSFUL FARMING ON AGRICULTURAL AND PASTORAL LANDS,"

(1) Specifically including the Department of Agriculture as an agency with which DHHL should partner to encourage farming by its beneficiaries;


