Your Committees on Transportation and International Affairs and Public Safety, Government Operations, and Military Affairs, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 43 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE LEGISLATURE TO SUPPORT THE EDUCATION OF HAWAII'S DRIVERS REGARDING THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES TO BLIND PEDESTRIANS,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to express strong support for the education of Hawaii's drivers regarding their responsibilities to blind pedestrians.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Transportation, Department of Human Services, and three individuals.

Act 75, Session Laws of Hawaii 1972, specifically established the responsibilities of drivers toward blind pedestrians, yet thirty-nine years later, none of Hawaii's counties have included questions about these responsibilities on driver's licensing examinations. In 2010, Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 10 and Senate Resolution No. 20 requested improvements in public awareness with regard to drivers' responsibilities to blind pedestrians. These resolutions called for the inclusion of questions regarding drivers' responsibilities to blind pedestrians on all state drivers' license examinations. These resolutions also requested the Department of Education to discuss responsibilities toward blind pedestrians in its drivers' education program. However, neither measure was heard, and your
