SB 6 RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL LANDS. AGL, WLH

Testimony

Protects agriculturally suitable lands within the State of Hawaii (lands

with productivity ratings of "A" or "B").

<u>Status</u>

SB 247 RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. AGL, WAM

Testimony
Requires the department of agriculture to establish a program to award grants to agricultural producers who implement natural farming, including methods such as Cho global. Makes an appropriation.

SB 249 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGL, WAM

Testimony AGRICULTURE.

Appropriates funds to the department of agriculture to: acquire a slaughterhouse within the Campbell Industrial Park on the island of

Oahu; to fund necessary construction, renovation, and improvement

projects; and to purchase equipment for the slaughterhouse.

SB 286 RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. AGL, WAM

Testimony Requires the board of agriculture to designate agents to inspect

agricultural commodities in underserved, remote areas.

**Status** 

SB 281 RELATING TO ANIMAL INDUSTRY. AGL, WAM

Authorizes the use or rental of animal quarantine property or facilities for commercial purposes. Establishes the animal industry special fund.

Status Makes an appropriation.
