Adopts amendments to the insurance code to comply with the federal Nonadmitted and Reinsurance Reform Act of 2010 relating to surplus lines insurance and participate in a multi-state cooperative to collect surplus lines premium taxes and fees and distribute to the individual states the taxes and fees they assessed. SB 583 Testimony Status	RELATING TO CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEMS. Allows the director of commerce and consumer affairs to designate an access organization to oversee public, educational, and governmental channels on cable television.	CPN, WAM
SB 644 Testimony Status	RELATING TO LIQUOR TAX LAW. Reduces the gallonage tax on the first 60,000 barrels of beer brewed or produced during a taxable year by a small brewery or brewpub in the State to \$0.23 per gallon of beer.	CPN, WAM
SB 1462 Testimony Status	RELATING TO PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATIONS. Establishes an organizational and regulatory framework for public benefit corporations.	CPN, WAM
SB 1540 Testimony Status	RELATING TO TAXATION. Requires a tax clearance before a professional or vocational license may be issued or renewed. Applies to taxable years beginning after December 31, 2012.	CPN, WAM
