Testimony Provides a private cause of action for a victim who, as a result of an Status information security breach, suffers a risk of harm from identity theft.

Amends the type of notice that must be given to a person affected by a

security breach. Defines identity theft.

SB796 RELATING TO INFORMATION. EDT/CPN/JDL, WAM

<u>Testimony</u> Requires a business or government agency responsible for the

<u>Status</u> inadvertent, unauthorized disclosure of personal information to pay for

the person's access to credit reports for at least three years.

No testimony will be accepted.
