SB 658 Testimony Status	RELATING TO ATTORNEYS' FEES.  Provides for the award of attorneys' fees to the prevailing party in the administrative process for external review of a managed care plan's decision.	CPN
SB 674 Testimony Status	RELATING TO LOW-PROFIT LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES. Provides for the creation of low-profit limited liability companies under the uniform limited liability company act.	CPN
SB 1349 Testimony Status	RELATING TO NONPROFIT CORPORATIONS.  Amends the Hawaii nonprofit corporations act to permit member actions by ballot and electronic voting, use of electronic notice, and conduct of meeting by teleconference.	CPN
SB 1086 Testimony Status	RELATING TO CONSUMER INFORMATION. Requires bread products that have been baked and then frozen to be labeled "previously frozen". Prohibits bread that has been frozen to be labeled or advertised as "fresh".	CPN
SB 1430 Testimony Status	RELATING TO THE PETROLEUM INDUSTRY. Increases the minimum distance between dealer-operated gasoline stations and new stations owned and operated by a manufacturer or wholesaler, from one-eighth of a mile to one mile.	CPN
SB 1431 Testimony	RELATING TO PETROLEUM PRODUCTS. Allows gasoline dealers to enter into cooperative purchasing agreements to acquire discounts on gasoline purchases.	CPN
