EDN, FIN HB 1055 RELATING TO EDUCATION. Repeal the administration of nationally normed reference test. <u>Status</u> RELATING TO CAPITAL INVESTMENTS. EDN, FIN HB 1058 Amends chapter 37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to include agency-wide Status technology and computer systems with an estimated useful life of greater than seven years as capital investments to allow all costs to be financed with bond funds and depreciated as capital investments. EDN/LAB, FIN RELATING TO EDUCATION.
