HB 1307, HD1 RELATING TO TAXATION. EDT, WAM

(HSCR801) Provides a temporary tax credit for residential construction and remodeling projects. Requires a report to the legislature comparing the impact on jobs and the state budget for various tax credit applications.

Status Effective July 1, 2112. (HB1307 HD1)

HB 418, HD1 RELATING TO GENERAL EXCISE TAX LAW. EDT, WAM

(HSCR671) Amends the thresholds of annual tax liability at which the Director of Taxation is authorized to require the remittance of taxes via an approved electronic funds transfer method. Effective July 1, 2030.

Status (HB418 HD1)

HB 618, HD1 RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ORDER. EDT, JDL

(HSCR635)

Makes the use of another person's name or persona to create a web page on or to post one or more messages on a commercial social networking site, without the permission of the other person, and with the intent to harm, defraud, intimidate, or threaten any person, a misdemeanor. Makes the repeated commission of this offense a class C felony. Provides that harassment by impersonation, if committed with the intent to solicit a response by emergency services personnel, is

a class C felony. Effective January 7, 2059. (HD618 HD1)

HB 306, HD1 RELATING TO TAXATION. EDT, WAM

Amends the method of computing the estate and transfer tax. Repeals the income tax credit for resident taxpayers for income taxes paid to other jurisdictions. Imposes an excise tax on direct broadcast satellite

Status service providers. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB306 HD1)

HB 1300, HD2 RELATING TO TAXATION. EDT, WAM

(HSCR864)
Requires the Department of Taxation to establish a system to allow taxpayers to file all tax returns, applications, reports, and other documents electronically; provided that there is no additional cost to

Status the taxpayer for the electronic filing. Reestablishes the end of the month as the deadline for filing and payment of various taxes.

Effective July 1, 2112. (HB1300 HD2)
