Status

Makes the work opportunity income tax credit operative for the taxable

years beginning after 12/31/2010 and ending on 12/31/2013.

Provides a tax credit for increases in the total number of persons employed and total wages paid by a taxpayer between 2010 and 2012.

HB 811 Status

Provides a tax credit for increases in the total number of covered employees and total wages paid to covered employees by a taxpayer

between 2010 and 2012.
