SB 823, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1161)

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

TRN/ERB, FIN

Status

Provides procurement authority to semi-autonomous county public transit agencies, thus allowing them to function as semi-autonomous

agencies in their respective counties. Effective July 1, 2011.

SB 1324, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1110) Status

RELATING TO RENTAL MOTOR VEHICLE SURCHARGE TAX. Adjusts the rental motor vehicle surcharge tax. Makes appropriation

from the state highway fund. Effective July 1, 2011.

SB 1328, SD1, HD1

(HSCR1111)

<u>Status</u>

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

TRN, FIN

Increases the State motor vehicle registration fee from \$25 to \$45 and deposits the money into the State Highway Fund. Effective December

1, 2011.

SB 1329, SD1, HD1 (HSCR1164)

Status |

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE WEIGHT TAX.

TRN, FIN

Allows for increase in the State motor vehicle weight tax and deposits the money into the State Highway Fund. Effective December 1, 2011.

SB 1327, SD2, HD1

(HSCR1163)

Status

RELATING TO PASSENGER FACILITY CHARGES.

TRN, FIN

Authorizes the Department of Transportation to collect increases in passenger facility charges without amending the administrative rules.

Effective July 1, 2011.

SB 1247, SD2, HD1 (HSCR1080)

RELATING TO THE ALOHA TOWER DEVELOPMENT

TRN/WLO, FIN

CORPORATION.

Abolishes the Aloha Tower Development Corporation (ATDC). Status

Transfers the ATDC assets to the Hawaii Community Development Authority (HCDA). Establishes the Aloha Tower Complex under the jurisdiction of HCDA. Makes an appropriation. Effective July 1,

2011.

SB 98, SD2 (HSCR1030) Status

RELATING TO WATER CARRIERS.

TRN/CPC, FIN

Requires public hearings subject to specified notice requirements before PUC approval of a water carrier's certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN); specifies required findings for a

CPCN; requires posting of documents on PUC's website.
