Permits the public employees health fund board of trustees to retain an attorney independent of the attorney general's office to represent the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund. Requires health and other

benefit plans to be provided for collective bargaining units, retirees and other eligible beneficiaries. Transfers the public employees health fund board of trustees to the control of the department of Human

Resources.
