HB 1244 RELATING TO SOLEMNIZATION. JUD Status Allows for the refusal of services or accommodations related to the solemnization of same-sex marriages, civil unions, and other same-sex unions on religious grounds. RELATING TO LEGAL RELATIONSHIPS. HB 1453 JUD Status Establishes civil unions and provides to civil union partners the benefits and obligations conferred upon a couple by marriage. Provides for termination of civil unions through the judicial system. SB 232, SD1 RELATING TO CIVIL UNIONS. JUD (SSCR2) Extends the same rights, benefits, protections, and responsibilities of Status spouses in a marriage to partners in a civil union. Takes effect 1/1/2012. (SD1)
