HB376 HD1 RELATING TO STREAMLINING PERMIT, LICENSE, AND PGM/EDT, JDL

(HSCR830) APPROVAL APPLICATION PROCESSING.

Testimony Authorizes counties to contract with a third-party reviewer to streamline Status construction permit, license, and other application processing; provides

construction permit, license, and other application processing; provides that applications will be deemed approved if historic preservation division fails to review and comment within sixty days, and after thirty days if agencies fail to establish maximum time periods for permit and other application processing. Effective July 1, 3000. (HB376 HD1)
