#### DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

SB1393 RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. WLH, WAM

Testimony Authorizes the inclusion of dams and reservoirs serving important Status agriculture lands in the total acreage calculation for important agricul

agriculture lands in the total acreage calculation for important agriculture lands; provides tax credits for dam remediation, aquacultural facilities, certain agricultural processing facilities, and certain agricultural worker housing; grants priority to aquacultural activities at state-owned harbors; includes aquaculture in agricultural activities; authorizes the board to

create standards for certain agricultural worker housing.

SB1559 RELATING TO IMPORTANT AGRICULTURAL LANDS. WLH, WAM

<u>Testimony</u> Establishes incentives for important agricultural lands, including <u>Status</u> reduction of unnecessary infrastructure requirements, expedited

permitting procedures, tax incentives, and funding mechanisms for dams that provide irrigation for agricultural activities on important agricultural

lands.

SB1530 RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS. TSM/WLH, WAM

<u>Testimony</u> Authorizes BLNR to extend leases of public lands for commercial, hotel,

Status resort, or industrial use upon approval of a proposed development agreement to make substantial improvements to the premises.

SB185 RELATING TO LANDFILLS. WLH/PGM/ENE

<u>Testimony</u> Places a moratorium on any new solid waste landfills and the expansion of any existing private solid waste landfills on the leeward coast from

Kaena point to Waimanalo gulch on or after 8/1/11.

ENE/WLH/PGM, **Testimony** Extends the existence of the climate change task force until 6/30/13. WAM Status SB1310 RELATING TO SECTION 13 OF ACT 380, SESSION LAWS OF ENE/WLH. JDL **Testimony** HAWAII 1997. Status Removes the sunset date on the use of new safe harbor agreements, habitat conservation plans, and incidental take licenses as recovery options for conserving and protecting the State's threatened and endangered species. **SB202** RELATING TO LANDFILLS. ENE/WLH, JDL **Testimony** Requires public approval from residents within a 1-mile radius for the **Status** permitting of a new landfill or the expansion of an existing landfill. **SB688** RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENTS. ENE/WLH, JDL **Testimony** Exempts actions involving the construction of or changes or Status modifications to affordable housing located within areas zoned for residential or commercial use where the activity does not require a rezoning designation or a variance from environmental assessment requirements. **SB689** RELATING TO LAKE WILSON. WLH/ENE, WAM **Testimony** Establishes a pilot project within the department of land and natural Status resources to demonstrate the effectiveness of marine phytoremediation using plants that are native to Hawaii to remove pollutants and improve water clarity in Lake Wilson; appropriates funds for the project.
