WLH, WAM HB 1312, HD2 Provides that state fast lands and submerged lands may be leased. (HSCR835) Provides for the lease of fast lands and submerged lands of the Ala Wai boat harbor pursuant to requests for proposals. Effective July 1, **Testimony** 2030. (HB1312 HD2) **Status** RELATING TO SMALL BOAT HARBORS. WLH, WAM HB 1566, HD1 Permits commercial permits in Ala Wai and Keehi small boat harbors; (HSCR837) establishes that small boat harbor fees can be used only for the operating and maintenance of small boat the harbors; authorizes a **Testimony** process for a public-private partnership to develop a portion of Ala Status Wai small boat harbor; changes mooring fee rate process.
