TESTIMONY ON GOVERNOR'S MESSAGE NO. 629.

TO THE HONORABLE ROSALYN H. BAKER, CHAIR, AND MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE:

My name is Lee Ann Teshima and I am the Executive Officer for the Board of Nursing, Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("Department"). The Department thanks you for the opportunity to testify on Governor's Message No. 629, regarding the **reappointment** of Denise L. Cohen, APRN, to the Board of Nursing ("Board"). The Department supports the confirmation of Ms. Cohen's reappointment to the Board.

Ms. Cohen is being reappointed to the Board as a licensee member. She has been licensed as a Hawaii Registered Nurse since September 16, 1983, an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse since July 1, 1999, and received her prescriptive authority as an APRN on September 2, 2010. All three licenses are current, active and in good standing.

She has served on the Board since July 1, 2008, representing the County of Maui and is currently the Chair of the Board's Education Committee. As a devoted Board member, Ms. Cohen has attended 29 out of 31 meetings. Her extensive academic and administrative nursing experience enables her to understand the purpose of the Board and allows her to be an active participant as a licensee member.
