RELATING TO NEAL MIYAHIRA FOR CONSIDERATION AND CONFIRMATION TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE DEFERRED COMPENSATION PLAN

Dear Chair Hee, Vice Chair Shimabukuro, and Members of the Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in support for the nomination of Mr. Neal Miyahira to the State of Hawaii Deferred Compensation Plan Board.

Mr. Miyahira is the Divisional Administrator of Budget, Program Planning & Management Division within the Department of Budget & Finance. Although I have only known Mr. Miyahira for the last 5 months since being appointed to my current position, I have personally observed his demonstrated competency in financial matters related to budgeting, fiscal policy, and financial planning. This is, and has been, exemplified in Mr. Miyahira's ability to direct the Budget, Program Planning & Management Division of the State during these difficult financial times.

I urge the members of the Senate Committee on Judiciary & Labor to support his selection by voting favorably on his nomination and advancing G.M. 736 for full Senate confirmation.
