## TESTIMONY BY KALBERT K. YOUNG DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FINANCE STATE OF HAWAII TO THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON FINANCE HOUSE BILL NO. 1286, H.D. 1

February 28, 2011

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST BIOENERGY HAWAII, LLC.

House Bill No. 1286, H.D. 1, amends Act 110, SLH 2009, authorizing special purpose revenue bonds to assist BioEnergy Hawaii, LLC., by modifying the purposes of the authorization.

The Department has a technical comment on this bill. Act 110, SLH 2009, previously authorized \$100,000,000 of Special Purpose Revenue Bond authorization. Please note, however, under Section 144 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, tax exempt financing for industrial projects may be limited to \$10 million. We recommend that the project party consult with a bond counsel firm to determine if the project may qualify, under certain exemptions, for the full amount of tax-exempt financing.
