The Department of Hawaiian Home Lands supports the purpose and intent of this bill to carry out the objectives of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act as it relates to our Molokai agricultural lessees and their ability to adequately access the Molokai irritation system (MIS). This bill restores a benefit to these lessees and we appreciate this, and similar measures, that enable our agricultural lessees to be successful.

The department supports this measure provided that sufficient funding is made available to the Department of Agriculture to cover the operational costs of the MIS. We recommend thorough discussion and consultation with the Department of Agriculture (the lead agency) and the MIS users to ensure this reduced rate is pragmatic and sustainable.
