Re: HB1486 Support

Chairperson Chang, Representative Carroll and Members, thank you for the opportunity to support HB 1486. Representative Carroll, thank you very much for supporting this bill. Last session Governor Lingle vetoed SB 2547 indicating in her opinion that the bill neither offered a correct solution nor was enforceable by DLNR.

The proposed solution presented in HB 1486 states,

"Requires small boat harbor vessel permittees who, in the course of providing an excursion using state boating facilities, disembark fare-paying passengers in certain counties with the expectation that they will visit state property adjacent to quasi-public property during the excursion, to accompany passengers at all times while ashore."

The Hulopo'e Beach Park Council is a community-based organization, which includes representatives from the Lana'ians for Sensible Growth, the ILWU, the Four Seasons Resorts, Castle & Cooke (landowner) and the community-at-large, to oversee the management and use of the Hulopo'e Beach Park on the island of Lanai. The Park Council supports HB 1486 as it will address the problem of unauthorized commercial use of Hulopo'e Beach Park on Lanai by Maui tour boat operations.

The recently renovated Manele Small Boat Harbor and the adjacent Hulopo'e Beach Park are frequently overrun by several tour boat operators from Maui island and their passengers, resulting in overcrowding and misuse of Lana`i's only easily accessible beach park. These unregulated commercial activities have adversely impacted the residents of Lana`i who feel they are being driven away from the Harbor and the Beach by the large numbers of unsupervised tour boat patrons transported to Lana'i by these companies.

The proposed legislation would require the commercial operators to comply with the Hulopo'e Beach Park rules and regulations that have been approved by this Council and the County of Maui.
