## To the COMMITTEE ON LABOR & PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT

Representative Karl Rhoads Chair; Representative Kyle T. Yamashita, Vice Chair and Members of the Committee:

On behalf of Mr. Peter Ganaban, Business Manager, the officers and members of the Hawaii Laborers' Union, we support the increase of fines under HRS 396-10. We defer to the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations for the specific amounts of each fine.

However, we encourage the Committee to specifically address the category of serious and high gravity violations by the employer where fatalities occur. If the deceased worker has a family with children below the age of 21, they should be provided with immediate financial maintenance at the death of their father/husband/head of the household such that the normal living expenses are covered i.e. rent or mortgage, food, transportation, utilities, school, clothing, child care, medical and prescription drugs, etc. until such time as the family receives appropriate insurance proceeds. This is to prevent any further severe hardship on the family while the deceased workers' estate is being settled.
