The Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) supports the intent of this bill, as it is a step in expanding our current agricultural homesteading program and supporting of farm lessees.

DHHL currently contracts the University of Hawaii College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources (CTAHR) on an annual basis to provide technical assistance as outlined in the bill to our farm and pastoral lessees. This technical assistance program is already embedded in our Native Hawaiian Development Program and is funded by our Native Hawaiian Rehabilitation Fund. This bill legislates what already exists and is unnecessary.
