Chair Souki and Respected Members of the Committee;

My name is Reg White. I have served for 20 years as vp of Royal Star Hawaii Transit.

This bill does not include coverage regarding the visibility of the yield sign from the overtaking drivers position in traffic. Many times I cannot tell at present if the bus is flashing it's hazard warnings while making the drop/pickup or it's intention to come left, because the next vehicle at the stop is blocking the view of the entire right side of the bus in question. This act must not charge a driver who could not possibly have seen the yield sign when it was turned on.

In return for this special privilege for transit vehicles I think we are all owed full pullouts at each bus stop so that we regain the full use of all the lanes of our roadways and traffic may proceed smoothly while the bus makes it's pickups.
