<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of H.B. 725 is to substitute "parenting time" wherever the term "visitation" appears in the Hawaii Revised Statutes.

DEPARTMENT'S POSITION: The Department cannot support this bill for the following reasons:

- The definition of "visitation" is used identically in State and Federal laws and
 regulations and is applied by the Administration for Children and Families as a
 means to monitor the State's compliance with Federal requirements and required
 outcomes linked to "visitation".
- 2. Changing the definition could result in Chapter 587A, HRS becoming inconsistent with Federal Title IV-E requirements which could affect federal funding.
- The term "visitation" should be maintained because it also includes a child's time with their siblings and other significant persons.
