## In consideration of **HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 114 -**URGING THE REPAIR OF CULTURALLY SIGNIFICANT PLACES ON THE GROUNDS OF 'IOLANI PALACE

House Concurrent Resolution 114 urges the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department), in collaboration with the Friends of 'Iolani Palace, to fund repairs of the wrought iron fence and brick wall surrounding Pohukaina, as well as other improvements on the grounds of 'Iolani Palace (Palace). The Department can only support this measure if adequate capital improvement program (CIP) funds can be appropriated.

The Department currently does not have the funding to implement the aforementioned repairs and improvements as stated in this concurrent resolution. The Department has requested funding through House Bill 200, House Draft 1, for CIP funding through LNR 806, Item H-4, Lump Sum Park Improvements, Statewide, to design and construct Palace repairs and improvements as stated in this concurrent resolution. The Department would appreciate your support for our CIP funding request.
