URGING THE GOVERNOR OF HAWAII TO INVITE ALL APEC COUNTRIES TO ESTABLISH HONORARY CONSULS IN HAWAII AHEAD OF THE 2011 APEC SUMMIT.

Chair Awana, Vice Chair Hashem and Members of the House Committee on International Affairs.

The Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism (DBEDT) strongly supports HCR 11 / HR12, urging the Governor of Hawaii to invite all APEC countries to establish honorary consuls in Hawaii ahead of the 2011 APEC Summit.
