There is nothing simple or easy about fulfilling any one aspect of their daily work. As a tax paying citizen and informed voter, it is my civic duty and responsibility to demand support for the people who are willing to risk their lives (both ON and OFF duty) for my safety and that of my family and my community, and also the safety of our Governor and Judges.

The Division deserves the financial, capital and legal support of our State government. Our tax dollars should provide the equipment, training, and legal defense for our law enforcement officers for the reasons cited in this letter of support.

It is no secret that law enforcement costs money. Please support the brave men and women of the Sheriff's division to do their job well.
