MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SALARY INCREASES FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES

Senate Bill Nos. 1063, 1064, 1075, 1077, 1081, 1082 (text of 1082 improperly refers to Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund costs), and 1096 provide appropriations for Fiscal Years 2011-12 and 2012-13 for salary increases for public employees negotiated in collective bargaining agreements.

We oppose these bills. The State is not in a position to fund general salary increases for public employees at this time. Other vehicle bills are available to fund collective bargaining cost items should those be negotiated.
