MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SALARY INCREASES FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES

Senate Bill Nos. 1063, S.D. 1; 1064, S.D. 1; 1075, S.D. 1; 1077, S.D. 1; and 1096, S.D. 1, provide appropriations for Fiscal Years 2011-12 and 2012-13 for salary increases for public employees negotiated in collective bargaining agreements.

We oppose these bills to the extent that the State is not in a position to fund general salary increases for public employees at this time. Negotiations for collective bargaining are currently underway. Only the process of collaborative discussions between the employers and the union will determine whether salary revisions will result. However, from a financial perspective, the State's fiscal condition makes it highly unlikely that salary increases can be afforded.

In addition, the titles of these bills are too restrictive to serve as vehicle bills for cost items other than salaries. There are other vehicle bills available to fund collective bargaining cost items should those be negotiated.
