<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of this bill is to appropriate State general funds to the Department of Health and the Department of Human Services to expand certain health care services to qualified individuals and to finance projects at designated health centers throughout the State.

<u>DEPARTMENT'S POSITION</u>: The Department of Human Services (DHS)

supports the intent of this bill as it includes initiatives supportive of our goals and objectives but we are concerned about the cost implications generated by this proposal.

Given the State's current fiscal situation and the significant shortfalls in our health care payments program (HMS 401), DHS cannot support increases in general fund appropriations beyond what Governor Abercrombie has proposed in the Executive Biennium Budget for 2012-2013 for DHS.
