Requires the director of health to convene a mental health and substance abuse parity working group to determine how the State can come into compliance with federal mental health and substance abuse parity laws and regulations and enhance existing state parity laws. (SD1)	HLT/HUS, FIN
<a href="#">SB170, SD1</a>	RELATING TO SHIPPING CONTAINER INSPECTIONS. Authorizes the department of transportation and department of defense to inspect shipping containers for dangerous materials, including explosives. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)	PBM/TRN, JUD, FIN
<a href="#">SB250, SD1</a>	RELATING TO THE COMMISSION ON SALARIES. Requires commission on salaries to conduct a public hearing prior to submitting its recommendations to the legislature. (SD1)	LAB, FIN
<a href="#">SB729, SD1</a>	RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION. Clarifies the duties of the OEQC, director, and environmental council. Grants the director's authority to vote only in the event of a tie. (SD1)	EEP, FIN
<a href="#">SB1213, SD1</a>	RELATING TO PERMITTING. Establishes a temporary task force under the comptroller to review state and county administrative rules to be amended or repealed to expedite and make less burdensome the permitting and approval process. (SD1)	ERB, WLO, FIN
<a href="#">SB1309, SD1</a>	RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR SPECIAL FUND. Establishes fees for services provided by the office of the lieutenant governor. Specifies the authority of the lieutenant governor to issue apostilles. Requires the auditor to analyze the establishment of a lieutenant governor special fund. (SD1)	JUD, LMG, FIN
