# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE, ITS OFFICERS, OR ITS EMPLOYEES.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:
1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
3	immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
4	the Hawaii state constitution.
5	SECTION 2. A critical fiscal emergency exists. During the
6	regular session of 2011, a request was made for funds to satisfy
7	judgments and settlements of claims against the State for fiscal
8	year 2010-2011, but those funds were not appropriated.
9	Therefore, it is necessary to seek these emergency
10	appropriations to satisfy those judgments and settlements of
11	claims and to avoid further legal action and expense.

13	SECTION 3. The following sums or so much thereof as may be
14	necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 are appropriated out of the

28 SECTION 6. The sums hereinabove may be paid to the
29 respective persons, or for the satisfaction or settlement of the
30 respectively identified cases, and in several amounts
31 hereinabove set forth or in lesser amounts deemed appropriate,

- 1 upon checks issued by the comptroller; provided departments
- 2 shall obtain the approval of the attorney general before payment
- 3 of any claim can be made.
- 4 SECTION 7. Payment of interest shall be limited to the
- 5 period from the date of judgment, if applicable, to thirty days
- 6 after the effective date of this Act, as provided in section
- 7 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those cases to which the
- \$ statute applies.
- 9 SECTION 8. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
- 10 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
- 11 June 30, 2012, shall lapse to the credit of the respective fund
- 12 from which the money was appropriated.
- 13 SECTION 9. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 14 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 15 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 16 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 17 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 18 of this Act are severable.
- 19 SECTION 10. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
